Super Pro Junior Dragsters—Ages 13-17

Pro Junior Dragsters—Ages 6-12

1. All NHRA, NJ State rules and track guidelines must be followed
2. Social Security, Birth Certificates, NHRA license and membership must be on file and valid in order to race
3. When towing with a strap, the driver must be in the racecar—when towing with a dolly or tow bar the driver may ride in the tow vehicle
4. Under no circumstances is the driver to push the racecar by hand or drive it back under power to the pits
5. Children under the age of 17 are not permitted in the burn out box or starting line—Only the JD driver is permitted in this area in their car
6. Dial in must be on the car clearly before the car crosses the line at the fence in front of staging—once any of the portion of the car brakes the farthest point of the line, a dial in cannot be changed
7. Junior age rules: If you turn 18 on 12/31/22 you cannot run next year—if you turn 18 on 1/1/22 you can run as a junior for the remainder of the year—you can run your age group for your age on 1/1/22 or your current age (this is the same as the national program)
8. All Juniors will be put on a ladder 1st round.
9. Pro Junior & Sportsman Junior Dragsters Starting Line Rules:
 - o Once the car does its burnout and crosses the No Touch Line (located approximately 20' behind the starting line) one crew person may go forward and line up the car at the starting line—however adjustments to the car or physically touching the car or driver are not permitted
 - o In the case of an over stage situation there are NO Pullbacks in time runs or eliminations
 - o Pullbacks & Restarts are permitted in time runs - Pullbacks & Restarts are NOT permitted in eliminations
10. Super Pro Junior Dragster Starting Line Rules: unlike the Pro JD rules Super is much stricter—
 - o To keep consistency in the class once the car passes the No Touch Line the crew person cannot go past the line
 - o The driver must line him or herself up by themselves
 - o Pullbacks & Restarts are permitted in time runs - Pullbacks & Restarts are NOT permitted in eliminations
11. Deep Staging: it is permitted but not recognized and Can NOT appear on the car
12. All pit vehicles must have a 2021 NHRA pit vehicle permit and paperwork on file—pit vehicle rules need to be followed and there will be zero tolerance for violations—if violations occur this could lead to your racing privileges being revoked
13. Once the pair of cars clears the 330 line please make sure your child car is started and ready
14. **Junior Dragsters are not permitted to test on Tuesday nights!**
15. **NO JUNIOR DRAGSTERS ON BLACK FRIDAY!**
16. **ALL JD GOLF CARTS MUST HAVE A VERY VISIBLE FLAG**
17. **ALL DRIVERS MUST COMPLY WITH NEW NHRA RULE of NECK/COLLAR RESTRAINT DEVICE – a head and neck restraint device/system meeting SFI 38.1 is mandatory and must display a valid SFI label. See JD Rulebook page 42 for update to the rules.**
18. PLEASE MAKE SURE CHILDREN ARE UNDER PARENTAL SUPERVISION AT ALL TIMES
19. FOLLOW ALL PIT VEHICLE & TRACK RULES
20. Atco management reserves the right to condense classes depending on the number of entries/participants.
